Collaboration with Vivekananda College, DU

Govt. Model College, Deithor has been invited by Vivekananda College, University of Delhi, to collaborate as a partner institution under the Vidya Vistar (V2) Scheme. V2 is a special initiative of University of Delhi for developing academic cooperation between colleges of Delhi University with their counterparts in other universities of the country. Responding to the initiative taken up by Vivekananda college, Govt. Model College, Deithor has already submitted a proposal for collaboration in various aspects. The process, which will soon lead to a formal MoU is currently underway.

Government Model College, Deithor...The Genesis

Government Model College, Deithor Karbi Anglong is an Assam Government initiative. It has been established by the Department of Higher Education (DHE), Government of Assam with an intention of spreading higher education in remote and comparatively underdeveloped areas of the state. The funding for the college has been provided jointly by Government of Assam and Rashtriya Uchchatar Shikshya Abhiyan (RUSA). Dr. Dipok Kumar Bora joined as a principal of the college on 15th September 2020. Following Dr. Bora's appointment, seventeen Assistant Professors encompassing six departments i.e. English, Assamese, Economics, Education, Sociology and Political Science have been appointed by DHE. Honourable Education Minister of Assam Dr. Himanta Bishwa Sharma handed over the appointment letters to the newly appointed faculties on 19th December, 2020. A total of 63 students have enrolled in various programmes. The college has started regular classes from 28 December, 2020.
