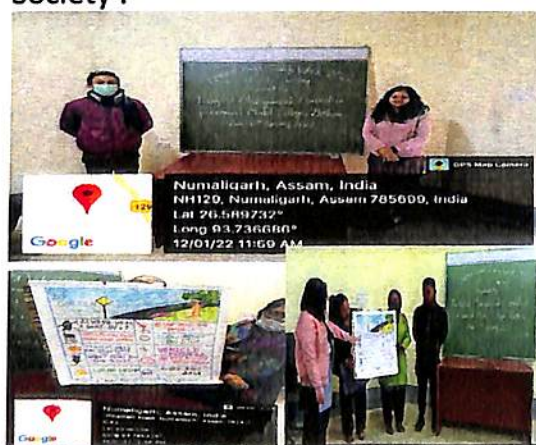
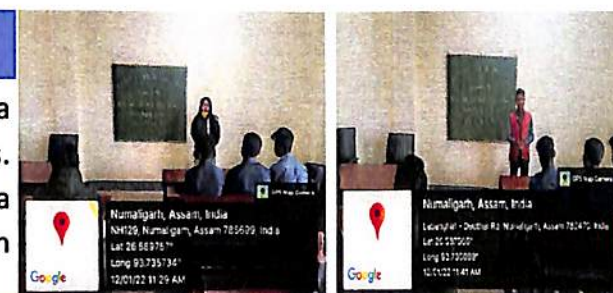

On 26/01/2022, Government Model College, Deithor celebrated 73rd Republic Day at its college premises.

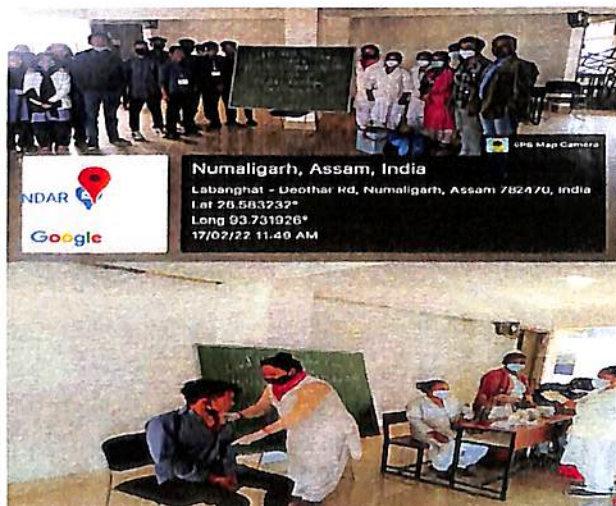
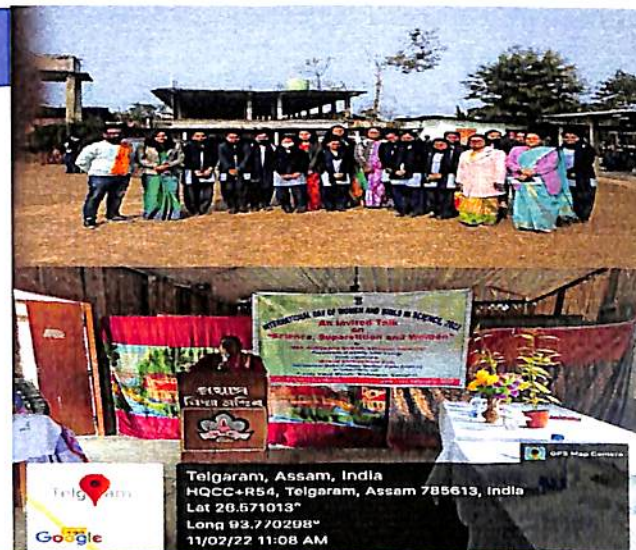


Third Parents-Teachers Meet

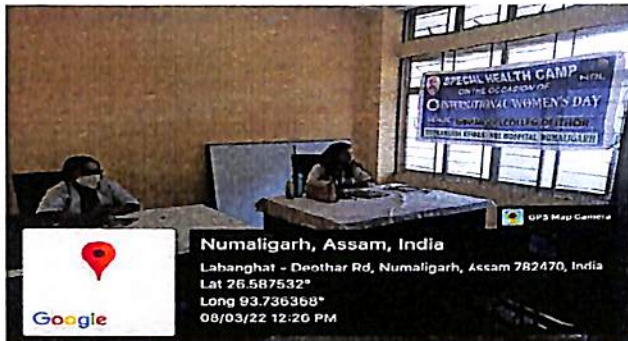


COVID-19 Vaccination Camp
