In many ways, book reading can be seen as a journey of self-emancipation—a reflexive process of discovering one's own reflexive “self”. At this crucial juncture, I strongly aspire to foster a vibrant culture enriched with positive habits such as book reading, buying and selling of quality books, presenting books as a gift etc. In this context, the recent decision of the Assam Government to declare 2025 as the “Year of Book Reading” is profoundly significant. The government's commitment to providing financial assistance for organizing book fairs in every district and offering special grants for employees to purchase books is a laudable step toward reviving the reading culture.

In response to the Honourable Chief Minister's initiative, we are pleased to announce that the faculty members of our college have created a welfare fund by contributing 100 each month. This fund will be utilized to support students in purchasing books. Additionally, the Department of English of Government Model College, Deithor, has already initiated plans to organize an essay competition to promote the intellectually enriching habit of book reading among students. I strongly believe that book reading should be popularized as a discursive practice—one where the buying and reading of quality books are celebrated as integral aspects of everyday life. In this spirit, the organization of various events to encourage reading, including holistic and inclusive book fairs, accommodating all sections of masses deserves high praise.
